Cuisine

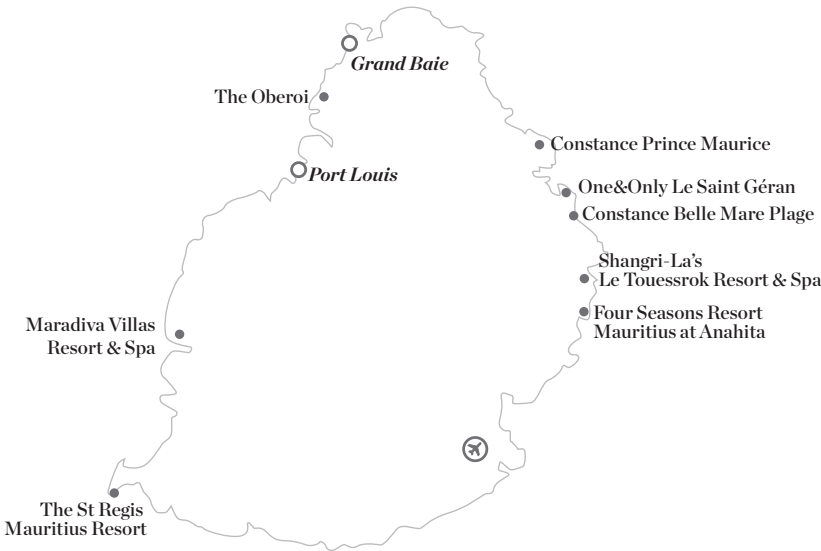
